A4AI-Nigeria Coalition

October 2014

- Nigeria was the 1st country to sign an MoU with A4AI, and A4AI was launched in Nigeria.

11th March 2014

- A4AI-Nigeria Forum, initiating multi-stakeholder consultative process that identified 3 potential barriers to improved broadband access and affordability:
 - Spectrum Policy
 - Infrastructure Sharing and Open Access
 - Consumer Advocacy and Pricing Transparency



A4AI-Nigeria Coalition

March - April 2014

- A4AI-Nigeria Coalition established, with stakeholders asked to formally commit to the process.
- Three A4AI-Nigeria Working Groups were established, one for each of the three priority issues.

July 2014

- 1st A4AI-Nigeria coalition meeting held in Lagos: stakeholders discuss the three primary issues and begin developing work plans.
- Two expert workshops held in Lagos - spectrum and consumer advocacy.



A4AI-Nigeria Coalition

August 2014

- A4AI Nigeria Coalition National Champions appointed

July-September 2014

- Work plans for the three primary issues finalized
- A4AI has approached a potential National Coordinator

January 2015

- Ministry of Communications and Technology asked to comment on existing work plans and promptly reply with further guidance.
- A4AI make presentation to Broadband Council

February 2015

- NCC appoints Engr. Abraham Oshadami, Assistant Director, Spectrum Administration as Champion for the Spectrum Working Group.
